



## CALL FOR POSTERS SCECSAL XXIV WINDHOEK, NAMIBIA

**VENUE:** Safari Hotel, Windhoek, Namibia

### Poster Topics

Present a new idea/service/programme or application of technology that has a clear relationship to the Theme *“Inclusive Libraries and Information Services Toward Achieving Prosperity for Sustainable Development in Africa”*

The main subthemes include the following:

1. **Digital libraries, digital scholarship and open access**
2. **Digital Preservation and Access**
3. **Enhancing access to records and archival materials**
4. **Indigenous knowledge and documentary heritage**
5. **Information for national development**
6. **Information Literacy Seeking and Access**
7. **Knowledge economy**
8. **Knowledge management**

9. **Open data and research data management**
10. **Specialized Information Systems**
11. **Transformation of the Library in the Era of 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution**

**Requirements:**

1. Abstracts should include the full title, full presenter list with affiliations, designation of the corresponding author, and contact information for the corresponding presenter;
2. Only a one page summary or abstract can be sent to Ms Hamwaalwa and Dr. Mchombu not a full poster;
3. Indicate the sub-theme under which the poster will be presented;
4. Your topic could be described on a printed poster or by photographs, graphics and text that you attach to the presentation panel;
5. The poster must be in English;
6. For printed posters, the standard poster size of **A1; 594mm (width) x 841 mm (height) or 23.4 inches (width) x 33.1 inches (height) or wide x 1189mm** high is the minimum size;
7. Pull-up banners stand alone are accepted- **850mm (width) x 2100mm (height);** and
8. Presenters of a poster will be expected to be present on **Monday 20 and Tuesday 21 April 2020** in order to explain their poster and to hand out any leaflets, or other information materials, they have available for viewers of their poster. Please note, only one poster per person is allowed.

**Best SCECSAL Poster 2020**

At the Conference the jury will view all posters and select the winner of the Best SCECSAL Poster 2020 based on the evaluation criteria outlined above. The winner will be announced at the Closing Ceremony on the **24 April 2020**.

Notification of the decisions on posters will be sent to corresponding presenter by e-mail on or before 20 November 2019.

### **19 April 2020**

Posters to be placed on presentation panels at the Conference Centre, Safari Hotel.
